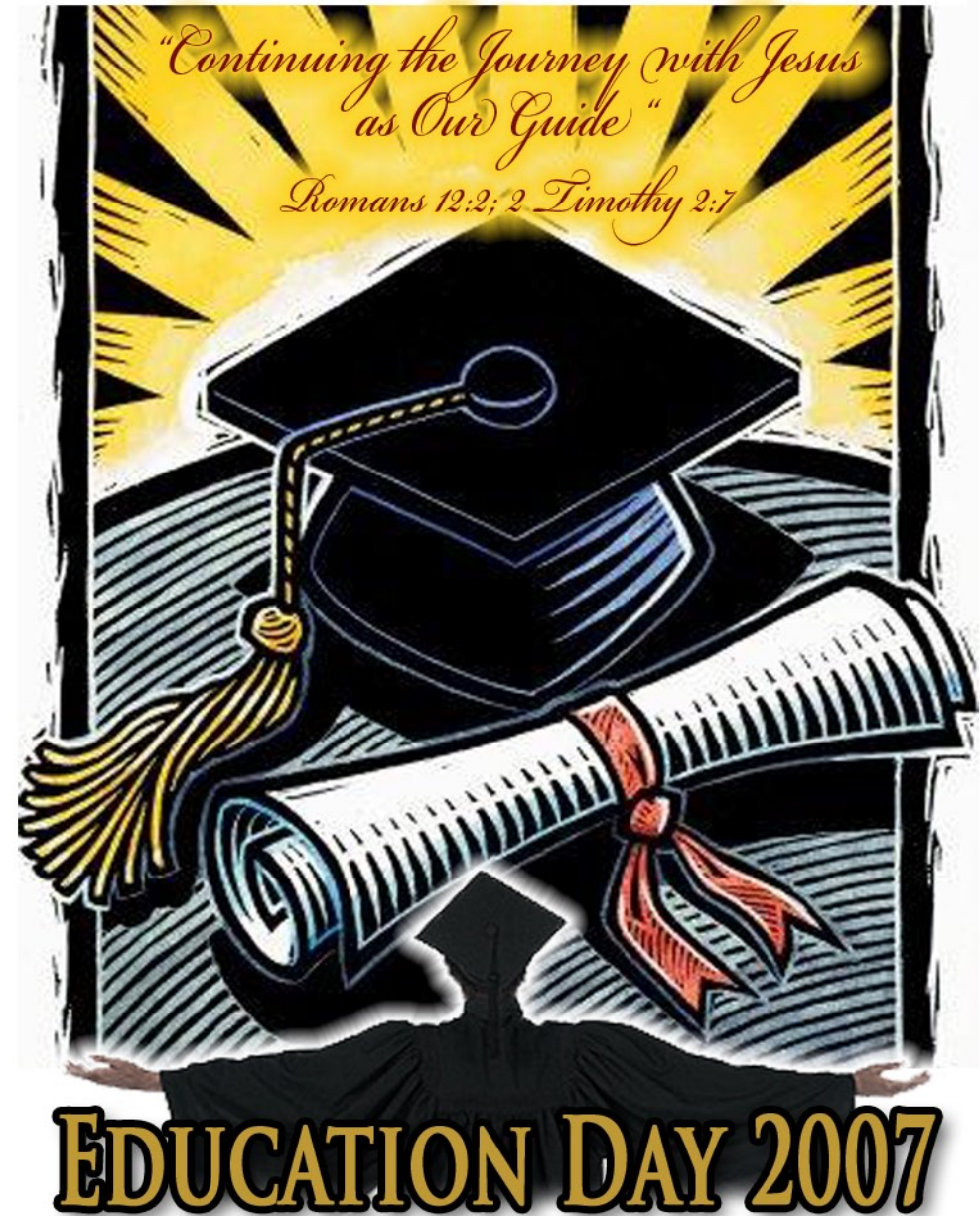

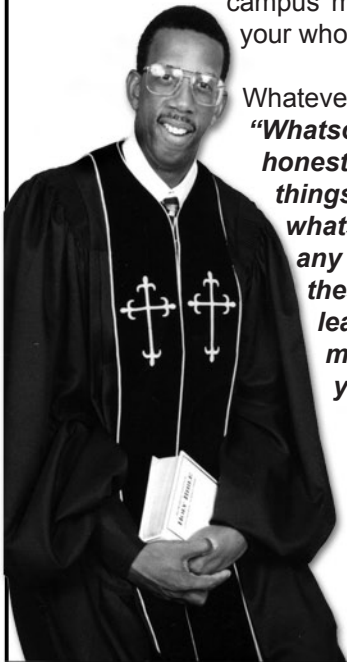

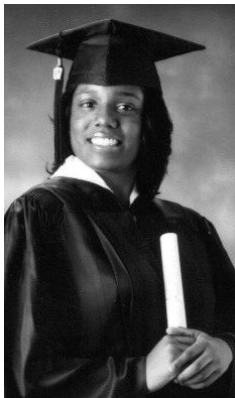

The Houston Independent School District will be providing FREE meals for all children this summer. Please see the flyer posted in the foyer for more information and participating schools.

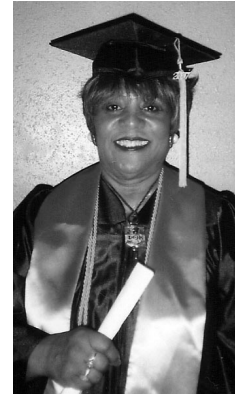
